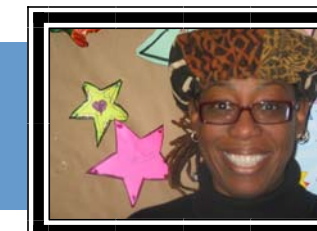
### The Rector's Remarks Wes Shields

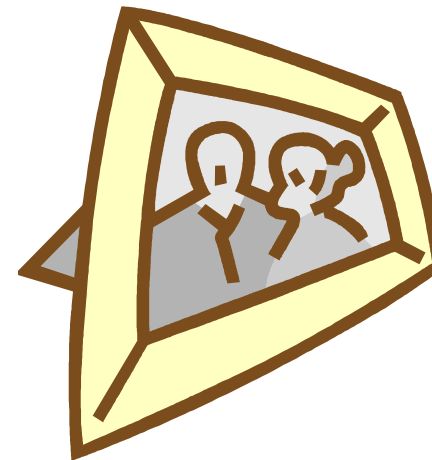

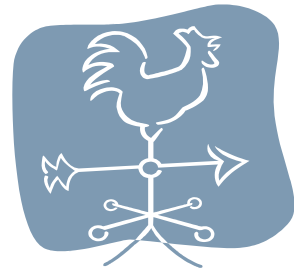

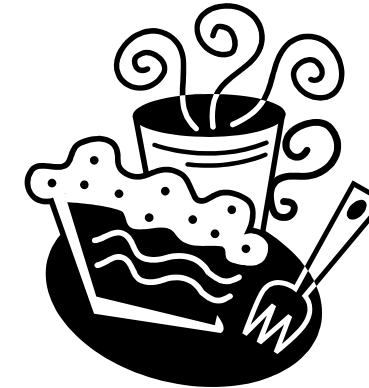
