DEAR FRIENDS,

2025 was certainly an eventful year for St. Andrew's. Not only did we start the year without a rector, but the Diocese was also in disarray—our bishop was gone and first we had the Right Rev. Katharine Jefferts Schori as assisting bishop and then later our current bishop, the Right Rev. Todd Ousley as Bishop Provisional.

Happily, things quickly fell into place for us; we had licensed worship leaders to lead services and Rev. Mary Caucutt agreed to be our "Super Supply Priest." By Easter she was coming two Sundays a month for communion and pastoral care. The Vestry went ahead with applying for a grant from the Diocese to renovate the Rectory and work started in June.

The Vestry took a hard look at every aspect of the running of St. Andrew's and initiated several projects to refresh our operations. We redid our web site, our pew cards, and have started on a new parish directory. We have begun having regular services at the Sublette Center. And, most importantly, we started the search process for a new rector. This was a slow process at first, but when Bishop Ousley arrived, he stepped up the pace. Our rector call was published at Thanksgiving, and we now have an applicant. Things are getting exciting. And the rectory project is coming to the finish line too!

Everyone at St. Andrew's has

stepped up to the plate, especially the Vestry. Sunday attendance is up, giving has stayed steady. We are clearly ready for what ever life throw at us. I look forward with excitement to what 2026 will bring to St. Andrew's in the Pines..

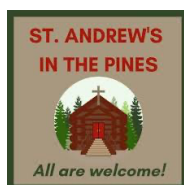

November 3, 2025

1. **Opening Prayer**
2. **Call to Order:** 5:33 pm. Present: Sukey Hohl, Senior Warden, Joni Mack, Treasurer, Julie Belton, Clerk, Sarah Hixson, Junior Warden, and Sandy Cenac and Kelley Pearson via Zoom.
3. **October Meeting Minutes:** Joni moved to have the October Minutes accepted as presented, Julie seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
4. **Rectory Update:** Joni reported that interior painting is in progress as well as bathroom tiling and new fixtures. Also the flooring for the bedrooms is here. Everything looks great. So far there have been no extra charges.
5. **Treasurer's Report/Grants/Fundraising:** Our finances remain steady. Pledge income is down, but we won't have a full picture until the end of the fiscal year. Next month we will be budget planning for 2026, which will be difficult due to the uncertainty of when we will get a new rector. Julie moved to approve the Treasurer's report and Kelley seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
6. **Stewardship.** Madeleine gave an excellent sermon on stewardship on November 2nd. Sukey will get a copy for next year's newsletter. Everything to do with stewardship month is on track.
7. **Transition/Search.** Sukey has heard from Bobbe Fitzhugh today. She has provided the additional questions we need to answer. Joni will take care of this since Sukey will be gone for two weeks and a lot of it is information she already has access to. Things are finally moving along. The Vestry agreed on a salary and benefits package offer. The final numbers will depend on who we chose, since much depends on how many hours he/she will work and how many family members there are.
8. **Preparation/Refresh:** Progress is being made with the pew cards, website refresh, photo parish directory, and services at the Sublette Center. Gretchen Yost will join us on December 7 after church to take head shots.
9. **Miscellaneous**
 - A. **Emails or Texts:** Sukey asked the Vestry whether they would prefer to communicate via text, but Kelley pointed out that emails provide a better record. We agreed we would use texts to point members to emails, if the emails need a fast reaction time.
 - B. **Laundry Ministry:** It was pointed out that the laundromat is struggling a bit due to illness in the family and we discussed various ways to help out. Kelley will reach out to the owners. Jocelyn has requested that we expand this ministry to Big Piney and Sarah will reach out to the laundromat owner there.
