St. Andrew's in the Pines Vestry Minutes
July 20, 2026

1. Call to Order: 5:34pm. Present: Rev. Leeann Culbreath, Sukey Hohl, Senior Warden, Sarah Hixson, Junior Warden, Joni Mack, Treasurer, Julie Belton, Clerk, and Kelley Pearson.

2. Opening Prayer

3. Reflection: Rev. Culbreath led the Vestry in an exercise that focused on St. Andrew's past, present and future.

4. June Meeting Minutes: Sarah moved to have the June minutes accepted as presented, Kelley seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

5. Financial Report and Bookkeeping Plan: Joni has met with Kayley, our administrative assistant and is training her to do bookkeeping tasks. Joni will continue to handle the money herself and deal with the bank. Joni reviewed our CDs, some of which she has recently renewed, and another is coming up soon. Financially we are in excellent shape, some budget line items are over, mostly due to the new gutters, but the bottom line is fine. Kelley asked about a payment for the Rectory remodeling project. The contractor didn't bill us till the new year, but the money was there and there were no cost overruns. There was discussion about putting some funds in a money market account; Joni will investigate.

6. Energy Audit. An Energy Auditor completed an audit of the church building to look for ways for us to save energy. He will present a report but he found nothing serious. A new "smart" thermostat and more weatherstripping will take care of most of it.

7. Vestry Retreat Recap and Next Steps: Rev. Culbreath will write all the notes and we will create a plan for the next steps.

8 Rector Report: Rev. Leeann reviewed her recent activities. She has been very busy, especially over Rendezvous. She also outlined her schedule for the next several months. She will be gone July 23 - 27, July 30 - August 4, August 26 to September 15 and again in January 2027. All of these dates reflect a combination of parish, Diocesan, and personal commitments. (She has a nine-month contract with St. Andrew's). She is also shifting her office hours 9:30 to 12:30 and changing her sabbath day from Friday to Monday.

9. Ranch Mass: Will be at Madeleine's on August 9th at 11 am.. We have new tents and Mother Leeann has her own sound system. We discussed signage and encouraging folks to bring their own plates and utensils. The church will bring back-up utensils, a tub for utensils, and paper products that can be composted at the rectory. Directions will be included in the next newsletters, etc.

10. Installation of New Ministry: Will take place on August 11 at 6 pm. This is in essence a Diocesan event. Mother Leeann has been working closely with the Diocesan Office planning the details. She will be sending out invitations next week. The Bishop will preside and a friend of Mother Leeann will preach. Symbolic gifts will be presented. We expect to host about 75 people. There will be a reception afterwards with heavy hors d'oeuvres and desserts. Sukey and Joni will manage the reception. The whole parish is encouraged to attend and pitch in to help.

Items 10 - 15: We deferred discussion due to time constraints.

16. Closing Prayer: Kelley led us in prayer.

17. Meeting adjourned at 7:21 pm.
